



This document details a few notes about parts for the 3DP90 parts kits, including ways that these kits differ from the published BOM.

Please review each item below for details. Note that items mentioned here are also called out with a * symbol in the BOM.

- At time of writing, some parts may be placed in an “extras” baggie separate from their dedicated parts baggies. As such, if a labeled bag is missing parts, please check for an “extra parts” baggie which may include these missing items.
- **General:** the 3DP90 release package is comprised of dozens – theoretically, hundreds – of variations in how you build the parts kit. We have attempted to provide hardware for most, but not all, of these variations. This means that, upon completing your build, you will likely have lots of hardware left over.

Furthermore, we have not ourselves built all, or even most, of these variants, and as such we may miss mistakes in the documentation or BOM (the above “extra parts” mentioned above are the result of one such documentation mistake.)

This all means that you may need to use judgement when building your 3DP90 to “make it work” if the exact part you need is not provided in the kit. For example, if the part called for is a socket head screw, but a button head is provided, this may still work and we invite you to try. If a screw is called for and that exact length is not available, you may be able to use a slightly longer one that is provided – or, you can cut down some of the extra hardware.

We hope that, as the 3DP90 continues iteration, a future version of this parts kit can be built that is much more exact. In the meantime, do your best as a builder, and please email us if you either have any questions, or if you find parts that are missing for your needs.
